EDITORIAL

THE FUTURE OF EDUCATION IN THE NORTH.

In this issue the detail results of the G.C.E. (O/L) is given, a perusal of which indicates the monumental success of the students. It was desided at the Ex-Committe meeting to send all the students who obtained ten As' Rs 1000/= as appreciation and letters of commendation. The results will have to be evaluated in the true perspective, to assess the significance. In the Metropolis or for that matter in any Provincial Capitals of Sri Lanka, the atmosphere, most conducive to the educational advancement of the children are provided with. Besides there is no obstacle placed, for the students to score high marks, as there is no external impediments like standardization.

But the situation in the North is poles apart. There are two factors that stand in the way of the students aspiring university education which are the repressive conditions in the North and the mode of selection to the Universities. There are the undivided commitment of the Teaching Staff, the stewardship of the Principals' and the excellence of the students themselves, who are refused to be drawn into other distracting vice. At a time the students should be able to study without having to bear burdens, are the Hartlyites able to devote at least part of their time to studies? The grim picture is that their hometown has undergone desecration, desolation & destruction of lives, livelihood of property & hospitals the students will have to think of survival first & not attending to studies. According to Swami Chithurananda of Point Pedro "Saratha Illam 'that the conditions at Point Pedro are tearful. The Print & Electronic media flash the news that the students have to queue as early as 5'0 clock in the morning and wait for hours before they get a loaf of bread. What is the time left for

the students to study? The pitiful news is that the much needed exercise books, the text books & the laboratory chemicals have not been made available at the Schools in adequate quantum. Pertaining to the basis of selection much had been published & criticized so that it does not warrant further elucidation.

The catastrophe of a generation not being giving proper education may be felt only after passage of time when a vacuum will be created in all spheres. It would be a Herculean task to fill this void later. In Western Europe most of the Nations have a dwindling male population, consequent to the annihilation caused by the German Reich effect of which is felt now with a majority female population. With all the appalling conditions in the North one could see a silver line in the sky. This is the spontaneous desire of the students to learn the English Language which is the positive manner to opt for a global passport. Science & Technology is playing a dominant part to change the pattern of life, mode of transport etc, to acquire a sound knowledge of which, English is the doorway. The results show that the students are taking keener interest & the Principal is sparing no pain to get English taught. He is in constant rapport with the O.B.A.(Colombo Branch) for whatever assistance.

It is of interest to note in this backdrop the state of affairs in Canada. Woefully, one of the Ex-Presidents of the Canada O.B.A. had unlocked his heart of the recent happenings there. It is causing severe heartache & pain of mind to note that the offshoots of Old Hartlyites have a flare in the acquired Language whereas they cannot even understand their Mother tongue. The

future leaders of the Society do not know an iota of Tamil, but in the middle age of their career the older generation is clamouring to conduct the meetings in Tamil. All what the elders are striving is for the posterity, and if they do not know the Mother tongue sooner than later Tamil will be an unknown Language as far as Canada is concerned. Instead of waging a fight in the Ex-Committee meetings to conduct the proceedings in Tamil it is worth the while as a first step to converse in Tamil at home. When you accept a Foster Country as your land of

living, you will have to accept their norms & values, nonetheless you must maintain your individuality too as to your Mother tongue and heritage. Especially the Gujeratis of North India are a classic example who accept the language of the Foster Country for Official work but it is their mother tongue, that holds sway at home. Even the Gujeratis children born in Sri Lanka, where Gujerati Language is unknown, speak their Mother Tongue at home, while being fluent in Sinhala and Tamil.

All the Cricket lovers must be relaxing only now after breaking sleep continuously at nights to watch the World Cup 2007 and the pressure was feverish high for most. Although Sri Lankan Cricketers lost only at the finals they were victors all the way up to the Finals. Even in the finals there is a consolation they lost to a Team, which cannot be subdued by any other Team in this Tournament and who are superior in all departments of the Game and who are real Professionals.

The O.B.A. Colombo Branch has a dual happiness in this World Cup for not only it made all of us to sit at the edge of the seats but one of our Vice-Presidents is also the Senior Vice – President of the Interim Board of Control of Cricket in Sri Lanka and he is none other than Mr. G. MATHYVANAN the omni –potent, who was at the venue of the World Cup at the Caribbean. He enjoyed together with other executive Officials of the Cricket Board the hospitality of the Organizing Committee of the



Caribbean Cricket Board. It is indeed a rare & a once and for all life chance to be an invitee for such an event of gigantic proportion. In quantitative terms about 1.5 billion people watched the Cricket matches on the electronic media while about 3.5 billion are glued to the T/V for Soccer World Cup and about 4.5 billion tune in their T/V when Olympics is on.

It is not surprising how "Mathy" as he is affectionately called, is well received by the highest in the Land yet he is very humble in life & noble in thought. As once it was reported in the "News Letter" the (Interim) Board of Control for Cricket in Sri Lanka is an exclusive preserve of the Aristocrats of the Major Community in Sri Lanka. However, the prestigious nomination to the Interim Cricket Board outside his business career, only cast luster on his many faceted personality.

On their return the Cricketers were accorded a very warm welcome by the Cricket loving masses of Sri Lanka at the Airport & en route to Colombo who braved the weather, when the sky opened up, and gave vent to their feeling. Mr Mathyvanan again made the Vote of Thanks at the meeting which was arranged by the Sports Ministry. In briefing the news media in his Official capacity, he made no scapegoat for the defeat in the final run up for the World Cup but he only felt that for the next World Cup to be staged in

the Asian cricket playing Nations that there will be a void created by the senior experienced players, calling it a day, which has to be filled by capable youths from the length & breadth of the Island. Gone are the days when the Sri Lanka cricket team is selected from the elite Colombo Schools.

By being appointed to the Interim Board of Control for cricket in Sri Lanka, Mr. Mathyvanan has brought honour to his Alma Mater. No others from the North had this rare privilege bestowed on them. In a befitting manner the Executive Committee unanimously decided to felicitate this unassuming personality, when the A.G.M is held on 29th July 2007, and award him a Plaque.

Justice S. Anandacoomaraswamy.



Probably there is no branch of study left without being mastered by some student or other in the annals of the history of Hartley College. Most students wish to enter the hallowed portals of the Medical Faculty of the University of Colombo, but for brainy Mathematics students nothing short of Engineering Faculty. There are students who have wits and have a flair for the Language who choose Law. In this field, while most prefer to be in the Bar there are few erudite Legal Scholars who by birth are sound in judgment, who wish to adore the Bench and by their unstinted service dispense Natural Justice & Rule of Law flawlessly.

One such eminent personality is Justice Anandacoomaraswamy. Only three Legal luminaries have adorned the highest seat of administering Justice from the original Point Pedro Electorate stretching from Thondamanaru to Karaveddi and they are Late Justices Dr. H.W.Thambiah, Late Sriskandarajah now Justice Anandacoomaraswamy amidst us. Only one Hartleyite has become a Supreme Court Judge and that honour falls on Justice Anandacoomaraswamy. One common factor among all these three Supreme Court Judges is that the first two were men of letters especially in the field of Law and the cool composed stature which attribute is equally possessed by Justice Ananadacoomaraswamy.

Hartley College has the honour of doing the work in making spade Justice Anandacoomaraswamy to continue in the field chosen by him guided by our revered Principal & Teachers. He was born in to a reputed family where it has become a tradition to take up to the Legal Profession. Therefore the choice came to him spontaneously. His grand father was a practicing Lawyer at Anuradhapura at a time, when the importance of English Language was not realized by many Northerners' and when the writer was as young as 8 year old. His one uncle was a Village Tribunal President whilst the other was the District Judge Jaffna. The stepping stone for an untarnished distinguished career was laid when he was successful in his Master of Laws (Colombo) in the year 1960 He was admitted & enrolled as an Advocate of the Supreme of Ceylon (now Sri-Lanka) in 1960

The period from 1966 to 1998 witnessed the graphical rise of Mr. Anandacoomaraswamy. He rose up from a Magistrate to District Judge and then High Court Judge. There was no travesty of justice. Especially after becoming High Court Judge, he acquitted himself with distinction and statesmanlike handling of the cases and endeared himself both to the Bar & Litigants. This earned him reputation from the highest in the Land.


He was promoted a Judge of the Court of Appeal which earned him the title "Justice "and soon became the President of the Court of Appeal. The highest point in his Legal career came by his way when he was appointed a Judge of the Supreme Court by Her Excellency the President of Sri Lanka. In addition to this exalted position he was also appointed as a Member of the Judicial Service Commission(1996 to 1998) and a Member of the Council of Legal Education.

His Public life did not come to an end when he retired as a Supreme Court Judge. He was hand picked by her Excellency again to Head the Bribery Commission. (1999 to 2004)

He has the unique distinction of being called for appointment by two different Presidents' of Sri Lanka for exalted appointments. He was appointed as the Chairman of the Human Rights Commission of Sri Lanka by the incumbent His Excellency the President. Although it is a pre-requisite to have been Supreme Court Judge to be appointed as Chairman of both Bribery Commission & Human's Rights Commission, the appointments bear special significance .All those involved in bribery and those who consider that there is violation of Human Rights will have to Appear before him, unlike when he was a Supreme Court Judge where only the litigants had to go before him to get justice What a fantastic & proud achievement for this soft spoken free going simple & affable Justice. He will be long remembered by the legal fraternity.

We also wish him many more years of useful service.

tremendous impetus for the younger in the family to further his own academic excellence.



Satkunarajah who is the man behind "Ranyas Graphics & S Print "who is responsible for printing our "News Letter "from the inception at half the cost, of what it would have cost to us had we approached any other printers'.

Mr Satkunarajah has now shot into prominence, of having been appointed as an Assistant Director of Education, Western Province and based at former Green Path Office, Provincial Office. Although the prospects of further promotions are on the card if the Ministry

He is applauded for creating an awareness among the student population of the leading role to be played by computer in the emerging society. He was essentially a self made man in this field picking up the threads of this new field, by intrinsic self application, and not under the tutelage of some one. He first studied the software & then the hardware and was the only source to supply question papers to the teachers

for the exams and prepared the tutorials for Tutorials centers for pre university classes. As the popularity grew with passage of time his services were sought after by leading teachers Schools and even Government Agencies, and U.N agencies like UNICEF, and NGO SIDA Therefore his services were sougst Peninsula wise. A void was created in Point Pedro when he was transferred to Puwakpitiya in 1999.

At 44years of age this appointment is only a stepping stone for greater honours to be bestowed on him in the years to come. Hartley College situated at the Northern most part of the Island Nation shot to prominence by dedicated & committed Principals & equally good Teachers who turned out students into various branches of study & fields. Mr Ganeshalingam is one

such personality who became the Mayor of Colombo and has the distinction of being only the fourth Tamil Mayor next to Late Sir Ratnajothy Saravanamuttu (First Ceylonese Mayor) Late Dr Jim Ratnam & Late Mr Rudra.

Born into a reputed family in Puloly, he had his early education under the tutelage of Late Mr. Pooranampillai & his able Teachers at Hartley College. The passion for Politics took a firm root in him from young days as a direct influence of the close association his Lawyer Father had with the renowned Lawyer from the Tamil Community the Late G.G.Ponnambalam. The latter's silver tongued oratory in English & the eloquent manner he conducted the criminal cases left an indelible impression on late Mr. Ganeshalingam's life. A spontaneous urge towards the great Orator slowly but steadily drew the late Ganeshalingam into the former's

political ideologies, thus starting the hidden political fervor in him even when he was young.

After the School career he had no difficulty in entering the University. At the University he was more involved in Union activities . He then joined Ford Rhodes & Thornton and learnt the salient features in Accounting & Auditing. On leaving the Auditing Firm he had a short stint with Ceylon Tobacco Corporation, but his inner urge was for him to start his own business. He ventured into Garments Export Industry and due to conscientious work, and detail to attention he prospered well having to his credit eight Factories spread out in Ratmalana, Mundel & Vavuniya. He never faltered his Customers as he steadfastly stood to business ethics. However the mundane business of making money for betterment of self attracted him little. Most of the earnings were spent on various Organization like even the Vivekananda Society & Literary & Cultural Associations.

The love he had for his Alma – Mater knew no bounds. From the inception when the P.P.A. Hartley College Colombo Branch ran into difficulties of meeting the ends, he would spontaneously offer a helping hand. Those were the days when there were not much Philanthropists amidst us in the Association. Apart from various Scholarship Funds he inaugurated and donated big sums, he came to the rescue of the Association, whenever we fell short of funds in our A.G.M. Meetings or any such events. By all sense he was a pillar of strength to the Association.

There was always one major problem that was in his mind and that was the National Problem and he was yearning for a meaningful solution but unfortunately during his lifetime he could not see anything fruitful.

The extent to which he commanded respect from People of all walks of life was amply demonstrated in a well attended funeral. Important personalities from major parties attended and paid glorious tributes in their funeral orations. There were messages of condolence received from His Excellency the President, the former President & Leader of the Opposition.

Most important achievement by him as Mayor was that he transformed the overdraft balance in the Bank, to credit balance of Rs. 5,000,000/= of the Colombo Municipal Council, in terms of the opposition Leader of the C.M.C, Mr, Vasudeva Nanayakkara.

He was a Financial Wizard, which factor enabled him to be taken into the vortex of the Party heirachehy, which prompted them to appoint him as the Treasurer of U.N.P. His achievements speak for themselves & he brought an unparalleled degree of dignity, courtesy, fairness, candour, and complete integrity to everything he did.

He was very much a man of the masses that he would never miss to grace any function, if invited, with his better half, and would add a glamour to the function with his characteristic laughter and interesting anecdotes. He was never class conscious.
